Surrey Place Centre ABA Student Placement

Surrey Place Centre provides specialized clinical services to help children and adults living with developmental disabilities, visual impairments and autism spectrum disorder reach their full potential. As a part of our comprehensive clinical services, Surrey Place ABA strategies assist children and youth to learn important skills in the areas of communication, social and interpersonal, daily living, emotional and behavioural regulation; teaching practical skills primarily through the use of group sessions. ABA Services also provides education to assist parents and caregivers in applying ABA strategies at home.

Surrey Place Centre ABA Services offers unique short-term placements to students who have identified a strong interest in working as an ABA Therapist and are enrolled in a Behavioural Science Technology, Autism and Behavioural Science or Behavioural Psychology program.

ABA STUDENTS WILL HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO:

- Under supervision, conduct behavioural assessment
- Assist in providing individual or group Applied Behaviour Analysis
- Improve research and clinical skills
- Create environmental supports and individualized materials for learners
- Further their knowledge of persons living with autism spectrum disorder
- Work with experienced clinicians in an interdisciplinary team setting
- Collect data and videotape groups

PLACEMENT CRITERIA:

- Demonstrated academic excellence
- Behavioural Science Technology Program, Autism and Behavioural Science Program, B.A.A in Behavioural Psychology
- Demonstrated skills in area of ABA
- Understanding of developmental disabilities or a demonstrated interest in working with persons living with developmental disabilities
- Articulated learning goals for placement
- Statement of Understanding between academic institution and SPC with evidence of WSIB coverage (not covered by SPC)
- Flexible schedule —some evening and weekend attendance may be required
- French is considered an asset

Available placement per session: 3 to 4 placements per quarter

Application Deadlines:

Q1 placement (April to June)	March 1
Q2 placement (July to Sept)	June 1
Q3 placement (October to December)	Sept 1
Q4 placement (January to April)	Dec 1
