Surrey Place Centre TRE ADD Placement

Surrey Place Centre provides specialized clinical services to help children and adults living with developmental disabilities, visual impairments and autism spectrum disorder to reach their full potential.

Housed within section 23 classrooms and run in conjunction with school boards, TRE-ADD (Treatment, Research, Education, Autism and Developmental Disorders) uses Applied Behaviour Analysis (ABA) to target reduction of problem behaviours and increase client skills. TRE-ADD provides assessment and treatment services for school aged children and youth from 6 to 18 years old who have been diagnosed with Autism and related disorders and deemed to have multiple and complex needs. Services are delivered by a multi-disciplinary team which includes Instructor Therapists, Supervising Therapists, Clinical Supervisors, Family Support Coaches, and school board staff.

TRE ADD STUDENTS WILL HAVE OPPORTUNITY TO:

- Shadow staff providing ABA
- Support staff and clients during group treatment sessions, including lunch, breaks, and circle times
- Create environmental supports and individualized materials for learners
- Further their knowledge of persons living with autism spectrum disorder and developmental disorders
- Work with experienced clinicians in an interdisciplinary team setting
- Collect data during treatment sessions

PLACEMENT CRITERIA:

- Behavioural Science Technology Program or Autism and Behavioural Science Program
- Demonstrated initiative to learn new skills and gain experience and knowledge
- Demonstrated skills / knowledge in area of ABA based services
- Basic understanding of developmental disabilities
- Ability to take positive and critical feedback to continually learn and improve practices
- Clear learning goals for placement
- Statement of Understanding between academic institution and SPC with evidence of WSIB coverage (not covered by SPC)

Available placements: 6 (depending on supervisor availability)
