and Developmental Disabilities (IDD)


I am getting the COVID-19 vaccine. This will help me stay safe and healthy.



I arrive at the clinic. Someone will tell me where to go.

I make sure to bring my health card or other photo ID.

I will fill out a screening form.



I will keep a safe distance by standing on the line or other marks on the floor.

I will wait my turn.

I can take deep breaths
and count to 10.



When it is my turn I will
be called to the clerk.

They will take my
screening form and
personal information and
tell me where to go next.

I will follow the marks on the floor to get to the nurse.

I will wait my turn and keep a safe distance from others.



It is almost my turn.

I can keep breathing or counting while I wait.

When it is my turn, I will sit down with the nurse.

She will read my screening form and might ask me questions.



The nurse will ask me to roll up my sleeve.

Then the nurse will clean the skin on my arm. This will feel cold and wet.

The needle will go into my arm. This will feel like a quick pinch and won't last long.

I can look away and take deep breaths.




The nurse will put a bandage on my arm.

The needle part is done.

I did a great job!

The nurse will give me papers to take home.

They will tell me how long I have to wait before I can leave.



I will go to the waiting area to make sure I am safe before leaving.

Someone can help me by setting a timer while I wait.

When I am done waiting I will check-out with the clerk.

They will let me know if I need to come back.



I did it!

Now I can leave and do something fun!
